

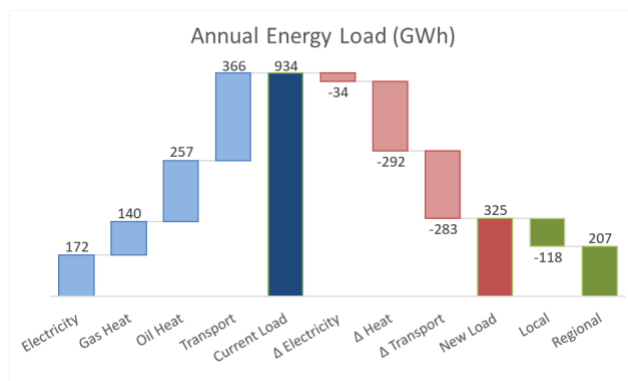


PLAN YOUR COMMUNITY'S SHIFT TO 100% RENEWABLE ENERGY
